C.S.I.: B.C. - Dr. Faso

During this one week investigation we will use many different scientific forensic techniques to collect and analyze clues of a staged crime scene. Everyone in the class will collect crime scene evidence and use science to determine the criminal's identity. You'll be introduced to all of the labs at B.C., Biology, Chemistry and Physics. We will use digital photography and computers to help solve this case.

Math Enrichment - Mr. Rodgers

Students will learn the basic concepts in Algebra II to help them get a head start on honors level math courses.

Math Basics - Mr. Rodgers

Students will review concepts in basic math to insure a solid background to be used in high school math courses.

Multimedia - Mr. Charles

In the age of information, this class will touch on the basic use of MS Office, Windows Moviemaker and proper etiquette. Students will create small projects using the skills from various programs they learn during the week.

Project 2: Self Portraits in Acrylics – paint your own self -portrait from a photo of yourself (school photos work well). Learn to manipulate paint, color mixing, paint application and how to interpret what you see will be covered.
