Thank you to the students who took the time to complete the Prom Survey. The feedback was extremely helpful.

In the desire to have a Senior Prom, I am excited to announce the following:

- The Senior Prom will be rescheduled for an evening during the week of June 15 – June 20. We will attempt to reserve a catering hall but if unsuccessful, the Senior Prom will be held in the Bergen Catholic gym and café.
- However, if social restrictions remain in place in June or it is deemed unwise to hold a large in-person event, the Senior Prom will be rescheduled for an evening during the week of July 20 - July 25. As noted earlier, we will attempt to reserve a catering hall but if unsuccessful, the prom will be held in the Bergen Catholic gym and café.
- If social restrictions remain in place in July or it is deemed unwise to hold a large in-person event, unfortunately the prom will be cancelled. However, if this occurs an event in honor of the Class of 2020 will be organized and held at some point during the 2020-21 school year at Bergen Catholic.

If this is the case, the gym and café will be decorated in a manner that denotes the importance of the evening, as well as creating the correct atmosphere. Fine food and music will also be provided. The Senior Prom will most certainly be an enjoyable experience for all – regardless of the venue in which it is held.
